

<u>Camp Lutherhoma Fall Force Retreat: November 16-18, 2018</u> <u>Information and Family Registration Packet</u>

<u>Mission and Goals:</u> Fall Force is a weekend retreat specifically designed for 8-12 year old campers. During Fall Force the Camp Lutherhoma Staff hope that campers will...

- Reconnect with friends and counselors they met at summer camp.
- Create new relationships.
- Grow in their faith as they study God's Word.
- Possibly experience Camp Lutherhoma for the first time through this weekend format.

Ages and Cost:

8-12 year old campers: \$130.00 per camper

• Parents or adult leaders: FREE

Lodging:

Campers will stay in the bunk cabins with college age Camp Lutherhoma Summer Counselors. Campers will need to bring bedding (twin bunk bed) and towels.

Adults will stay in Pine or Aspen Retreat Cabins where bedding and towels are provided.

<u>Program:</u> Our camp counselors will lead cabin groups (divided by gender and age) of 7-9 campers through camp activities and Bible studies. We hope campers experience a weekend that feels like summer camp as they bond with their counselor and cabin mates and experience many fun activities and engaging Bible studies.

We hope the parents who attend also experience a glimpse of what happens during summer camp and also gain personal and spiritual growth through Bible studies, activities, and discussions created specifically for them. Parents will have many opportunities to interact with the campers they brought during meal times, whole group activities, and certain activity times.

Check In and Check Out:

On Friday, November 16th Registration Check-In will be from 8:00-9:00pm. A group welcome and the first activities will begin at 9:00pm.

On Sunday, November 18th Parents, families, and friends are welcome to join us for our Closing Program at 11:00am in the Outdoor Chapel. Campers will share songs and scripture they learned through the weekend. Everyone will be dismissed after the Closing Program and the camp store will be open for final purchases.

Registration: Due by Tuesday, November 6, 2018.

Follow the steps below as you register an adult family member and child(ren) (without a church group):

- 1. Go to www.lutherhoma.com and click "Account Login"
- 2. If you have not yet created an online account with Camp Lutherhoma, click "Create New Account" and then follow the directions below.
- 3. If you have an online account with Camp Lutherhoma, use your Existing Account to sign in.
 - a. Click "Register Online", then select "A Family"
 - b. Enter the quantities for each option (Adult Chaperone and Youth Participant) then click continue.

- c. First select "Enter Attendee Information" for the Adult Chaperone and complete the required information. If an adult chaperone is not listed on the drop down list, select "Add a New Individual"
 - i. To add a new adult individual (who has never been to camp before) you will need to input his or her birthdate, email address, and home address.
- d. Then fill out or revise the Medical History and Health information for the Parent or Adult Chaperone, clicking "Continue" at the bottom of each page as it's completed. You do not need to add the medication you take. Adults will be responsible for their own medication.
- e. Read and sign the Terms and Conditions information about background checks. This statement gives Camp Lutherhoma permission to conduct a background check on you per the Oklahoma District, Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod Youth Event Policy.
- f. Then select "Enter Attendee Information" to register your child(ren). Select the attendee from the drop-down list. If the Attendee is not listed, select "Add a New Individual".
 - i. To add a new camper individual (who has never been to camp before) you will need to add his or her birthdate.
- g. With each camper you register there is an option to add a roommate request. If your campers have a buddy they would like to bunk with please add that camper's name and that camper's PARENT's email address. We will do our best to honor these requests but also consider age and limited cabin size when making cabin assignments.
- h. You will then fill out or revise your camper's Medical History and Health Information. Please add any medication your child will take during the weekend at camp. This medication will be turned in at check-in on Friday and administered when scheduled.
- i. Once all the attendee information is complete, select "Check Out"
- j. If paying with credit card, please complete the steps on the screen. You will then get a confirmation e-mail. If paying with a check, contact Camp Lutherhoma to let us know. Make the check payable to Camp Lutherhoma and mail it to Camp Lutherhoma PO Box 1672, Tahlequah, OK 74465. Once we receive the check, we will process it, make your registration active, and you will get a confirmation e-mail.

Payment: There is a \$50 deposit per person due at the time of registration.
